Exchange History



The Quintus football exchange initially began in 1984 between Quintus and Dale Hall primary school. The introduction of Nol Vis and Graham Currey in 1988 grew the exchange to bi annual return visits as we know them today. In 2002 Felixstowe and Walton took over the reigns as the exchange and continue to this day.

The yearly English and Dutch legs have seen over 1,000 Dutch and English boys exchange homes experiencing new cultures, languages (including some rude words) and, for some, their first adventure to a different country. The coaches and the parents also created life long friendships with multiple regular visitors for each leg. The visit encapsulates the strong links between the clubs and countries with it becoming a lifelong memory for all concerned. All this cannot be achieved without the coaches, sponsors, volunteers and parents on both sides of the North Sea.

Now in its 39th year and 20th for Felixstowe, the exchange has grown from strength to strength despite the missed pandemic years. Playing for the now known Vis/Currey cup is the highlight of the weekend and long may it continue and it's all through the love of football

5v5 Festival Rules

- 1 This Competition is called 'Vis Currey Cup Annual Festival' and will be sanctioned by the Suffolk County FA / National FA
2. Age groups will relate to the 2023/24 season.
3. Each team shall register a squad of up to 8 players on the day of the competition.
4. If required, due to low squad numbers, we can ammend squads, during event.
5. All players must wear shin pads, appropriate footwear and remove all jewellery
6. All matches will be no longer than 10 minutes in duration. Then 2 minutes to get ready for next game.
7. There will be no half time
8. In the event of a clash of colours, the second named team should provide alternative shirts / bibs
9. The final will be between the teams that finish top of Group A and Group B. In group stage if teams have finished level on points it will be decided by goal difference. If goal difference is level we will have penalty shoot-out to decide. (all 5 players to take penalty).
10. Substitutes are roll on, roll off from those named on the registration form. A substituted player can return in the same match. Referee's must be informed of and allow substitutions. The number of substitutions made during a game is unlimited.
11. This competition uses the Sin Bin, yellow and red card system.
12. A player who is dismissed from the field of play for any reason apart from violent conduct, serious foul play, threatening, abusive, indecent or insulting words or behaviour shall be suspended automatically for one match in the Tournament immediately following the match in which he was sent off. This includes two yellow cards received within the same match or a straight red card.
13. A player who is dismissed from the field of play for violent conduct, serious foul play, threatening, abusive, indecent or insulting words or behaviour whether he has previously been cautioned in the match or not, shall be suspended automatically for two matches. This commenced immediately following the match in which he was sent off. Save for spitting at another person who will be suspended from the tournament and reported to The Football Association.
14. All extraordinary incident should be reported to The Football Association. In exceptional circumstances the Football Association may deem it necessary to impose a greater sanction.
15. All cautions and red cards will be dealt with on the day of the match. Any protests or appeals of this nature will be dealt with by the festival Management Committee. Their decisions are final.
16. The referee shall be responsible for reporting the result of the game to the result co-ordinator at the conclusion of each game.
17. The Winners & Runners-Up will receive a trophy and or medal

Code of Conduct for Spectators
